Our Event Room:



We have organized a very nice, big and air conditioned Seminar Room in the Hotel Hillinger.

You can use this Room continuously from Friday Noon up to Sunday 10:00 AM. The Room can be safely locked over night. The Room features free Wifi and plenty of power sources.

The Hotel features their own Restaurant and Bar to order Drinks and Snacks.

Hotel recommendation:

Hotel Hillinger is situated close to the United Nations headquarters, the Austria Center Vienna, and the modern business and shopping area in the north-east of the city. Free WiFi is available.

Only 4 kilometres from the centre and close to the A23 motorway, this hotel offers modern rooms, a large free car park, a coffee bar, and a restaurant with regularly changing specialities.

The Tram Line 25 directly holds in front of the Hotel and is only 4 Stations away (8 Minuten) from the Underground Station U1 *Kagran*. The Donauzentrum Shopping Centre is in the immediate vicinity of the hotel.

Room Prices:

If you book directly at the hotel, the prices are around:

- 65 € (single) per night and room, inclusive breakfast.
- 85 € (double) per night and room, inclusive breakfast.
- 105 € (triple) per night, and room, inclusive breakfast.

You can book on the website of the hotel (www.hillinger.at) or through the site of your favourite travel organisation (like Booking, Expedia, etc.).

Car Parking:

The Hotel offers a plenty of free parking slots for us. In addition you can park your car for free in this district of Vienna unless otherwise specified. In the inner districts of Vienna car parking is very limited possible.

Public Transport Connections:

The nearby underground station (line U1) called *Kagran* provides direct connections into Vienna's city centre within 10 minutes.

The tram number 25 stops directly at the hotel. The stop is called *Polgarstraße*. It brings you to the U1 Underground station *Kagran*.

Airport:

The airport of Vienna is called Wien-Schwechat (VIE). It has connections to London, Amsterdam, Brussels, Paris and so on.

You can choose between the following means of transportation.

S-Bahn S7:

The S7 will bring you from the airport to the train station *Praterstern*. Directly from there you can take the U1 underground to the station *Kagran* which is the closest U1 station to the Hotel. From there you best take the tram line 25 which brings you directly to the Hotel, Station *Polgarstraße*.

CAT:

The City Airport Train (CAT) goes directly from the airport to U3/U4 *Landstrasse (Wien-Mitte)* and back. It's a little bit more expensive. Details can be found on their Website.

Vienna Airport Lines (Postbus 1183):

The Vienna Airport Lines feature a good connection between the airport and Hotel Hillinger. A one-way ticket costs 8 €, a return ticket costs 13 €

Arrival:

At the Airport enter the Vienna Airport Lines Bus 1183 and exit at station *Donauzentrum*. From there you can use the tram 25 to get to the station *Polgarstraße*, where the hotel is located at.

Departure:

Enter the Bus 1183 at station *Kagraner Brücke (Hotel Lenas Donau)* or station *Donauzentrum* and exit at the Airport.

Airport-Taxi:

If you book your taxi in advance of your trip with one of many special airport taxi services, you can get a price of around 30 € for one way. If you simply order a general taxi or enter a taxi at the airport, it's gonna be hugely more expensive. (up to 50€).
