during the last European TI-Treffen in Rome (Italy) we proposed to organize the next Treffen in Germany. That was accepted, so the TI-Club Errorfree would like to invite you for this event in Augsburg.



The accommodation facilities are located in a part of the youth hostel Augsburg, called guesthouse "Living Cube". It is located in the centre of the city of Augsburg, it is cheap and it has an adequate seminar room. Everybody, also those without a membership of Hostelling International (was IYHF), may reserve it. The registration for the guesthouse, including advanced payment, has to be completed before mid-August 2012. Please see also the paragraph in the registration form.



If you are a member of Hostelling International you may register directly at the youth hostel by yourself. Please reserve rooms as soon as possible since the last weekend of September is the busiest convention period due to the 'Münchner-Okttoberfest'. Augsburg is situated just 50 km from Munich.

Founded in 15 B.C. by the Romans at the confluence of the rivers Lech and Wertach, Augsburg, along with Trier and Kempten, is one of Germany's three oldest cities. Particularly during the Renaissance, Rococo and Industrial eras, Augsburg played a leading role Europe-wide; today it is the third-largest city in the state of Bavaria. Famous sons of the city include the business magnate Jakob Fugger, the composer Leopold Mozart and the writer Bertolt Brecht.



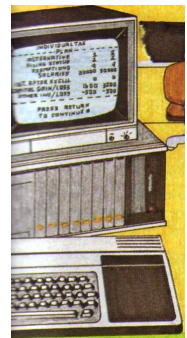

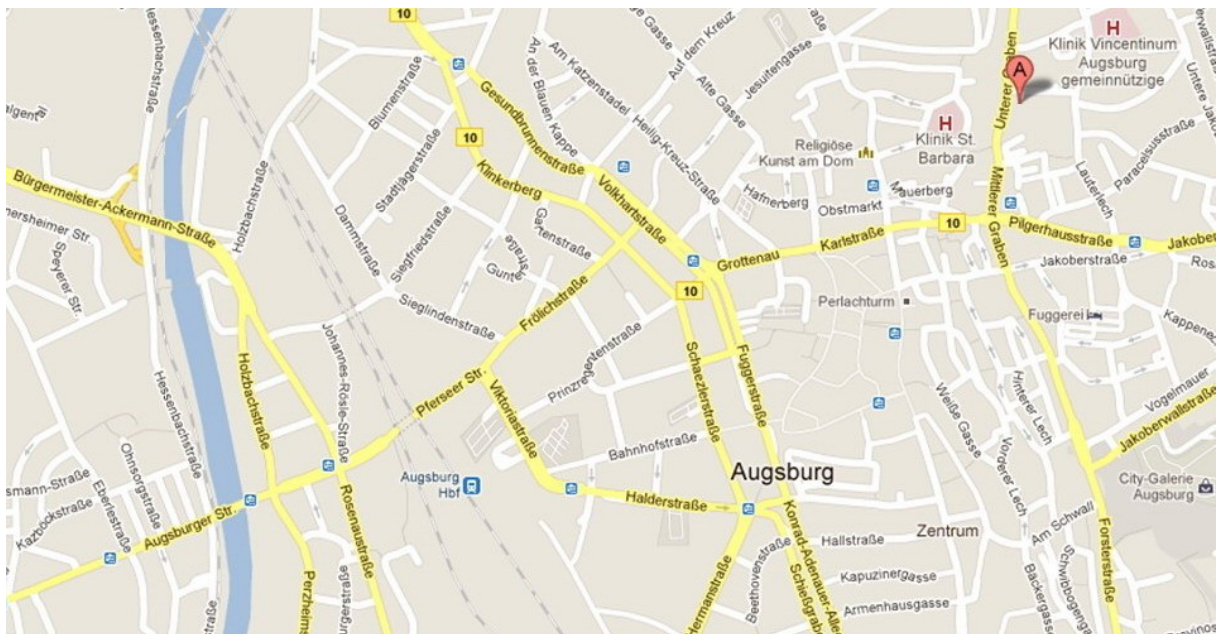

Arrival:

Starting from the train station Augsburg, you have to use the tram 3 or 4 till to the stop „Königsplatz“, than use tram 1 in direction „Neuer Ostfriedhof“ stop on „Barfüßerbrücke“. From there you need 5 minutes on foot to the youth hostel.

If you are coming by car on the Autobahn A8 using exit „Augsburg-Ost“ in direction „Augsburg-Zentrum“, following the „Mühlhauser“ street till to „Georg-Haidnl“ street, after Man-Roland turning left you will come to the street „Unteren Graben 6“.



For our friends coming by plane:

Via Munich airport, using the train to Augsburg main station

or

via Stuttgart airport, also using the train to Augsburg main station.

Another possibility is the airport Memmingen with flights of Ryanair.

You need a transfer via bus from Memmingen to Augsburg.
